Disability Worker Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct is a legal obligation under the Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018 (Vic).

All disability workers in Victoria must comply with the Code of Conduct:

Respect

- 1. Act with respect for individual rights to freedom of expression, self-determination and decision-making in accordance with applicable laws and conventions
- 2. Respect the **privacy** of people with disability

Quality

- 3. Provide supports and services in a safe and competent manner, with care and skill
- 4. Act with integrity, honesty and transparency
- 5. Promptly take steps to raise and act on concerns about matters that may impact the quality and safety of supports and services provided to people with disability

Safety

- 6. Take all reasonable steps to prevent and respond to all forms of violence against, and exploitation, neglect and abuse of, people with disability
- 7. Take all reasonable steps to prevent and respond to sexual misconduct

If you suspect a disability worker has breached the Code, report it to the Victorian Disability Worker Commission (VDWC).
