REVOCATION OF INTERIM PROHIBITION ORDER

Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018 Section 137

This revocation order is made pursuant to the *Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018*, section 137(1) which states that the Commissioner must revoke by order an interim prohibition order or prohibition order is satisfied that the interim prohibition order or prohibition order is no longer required to avoid serious risk to;

- (a) the life, health, safety or welfare of a person; or
- (b) the health, safety, or welfare of the public.

Date this revocation order is made:	1 October 2025
Date this revocation order takes effect:	12.01am on Thursday 2 October 2025 s.137(4) A revocation order takes effect on the date specified in the order, being a date after the publication of the order required under subsection (3)
Date on which the interim prohibition order expires:	There is an interim prohibition order in effect until 19 October 2025. This revocation order relates to this interim prohibition order and revokes it.

Effect of this Revocation Order:

The unregistered disability worker is no longer subject to an interim prohibition order effective, 12.01am on Thursday 2 October 2025 as the Commissioner is satisfied that the interim prohibition order is no longer required to avoid a serious risk to—

- (a) the life, health, safety or welfare of a person; or
- (b) the health, safety or welfare of the public.

This revocation order, lifts the restrictions placed on them by the interim prohibition order issued on 24 July 2025, which prohibited them from 'providing all disability services in Victoria'.

In this revocation order 'unregistered disability worker' and 'disability service' have the same meaning as in section 3 of the *Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018*.


This revocation order takes effect on Thursday 2 October 2025.
